Performing Manufacturing Operations Level 2

Learners need to complete 2 mandatory units to a total of 10 credits and a minimum of 25 credits from Optional Units Group 1 (3 units minimum) and a minimum of 13 credits from Optional Units Group 2 (1 unit minimum). To achieve the qualification a minimum of 48 credits is required.
